- Yes No I am happy to let the State of Minnesota distribute my money and property to my legal heirs, whomever they may be at my death.
- Yes No I don't care how much it will cost to distribute my estate to my heirs.
- Yes No I'm perfectly comfortable with my heirs getting their inheritance in a lump sum, however young they may be.

Scoring: 7 Yes = Congratulations! You do not need an estate plan.

6 or fewer Yes = You need an estate plan.
